Mercado de la Bretxa walk-through (Sun lonja stalls) \$

Plaza de la Bretxa, edge of Parte Vieja. Mon-Sat 8-2:30; Sun many stalls closed BUT lonja (fish) + bakers open ~9-1. Use this as the Monte Urgull warm-up — Bretxa sits 4 min walk from the Urgull trailhead.

The big hill before lunch.

12 min walk to entry at Plaza de Zuloaga (Parte Vieja), then ~30 min uphill via paved switchbacks. ~120 m climb, sneakers fine. Top: Sacred Heart statue, castle ruins, 360° city + bay view. Free. Down by 12:15 PM. [Open in Maps](#)

12:30 PM

Lunch at La Cuchara de San Telmo \$\$

Right at the base of Monte Urgull

in Parte Vieja — perfect post-hike payoff. Open Sun (12:30-3:30 PM). Cult hot pintxos: braised veal cheek in red wine, foie gras, octopus. €4-7 per pintxo, eat 4-5 + drinks = €30-40 pp. MORE +

~3 hr Viator tour — guided pintxos + wine through Parte Vieja. Treat lunch as your warm-up; the tour is round 2. [Open in Maps](#)

Walk off the food. Surfing + sunset spot. Different vibe from La Concha. [Open in Maps](#)

 **SUNDAY Pintxos Crawl — Parte Vieja (6 stops, all Sun-open)** \$\$



START 7:00 SHARP.

Three stops (Goiz-Argi, La Cuchara, La Viña) only open at 7 PM, and

La Cuchara + La Viña both CLOSE at 11 PM

— move briskly to land the cheesecake finish in time.

Néstor + Borda Berri are CLOSED Sundays

— not on this route. All 6 within a 5-min walk; one or two pintxos + a drink each, standing. ~€80-100 for two.

Order (verified Sun Jun 28 hours):

- 1. Goiz-Argi** (7:00 opener — Sun 6:30-10:30 PM) — legendary grilled prawn brochette (brocheta de gambas) + grilled baby squid.
- 2. Casa Urola** (Sun 7-11:15 PM) — heartier stop (Néstor's replacement): scallop, grilled fish, txuleta.
- 3. La Cuchara de San Telmo** (Sun 7-11 PM) — foie gras, slow-cooked pig's ear, octopus. Cult cooked-to-order.
- 4. Atari Gastroleku** (Sun 12:30-11 PM) — beef cheek + txuleton, outdoor tables facing the basilica.
- 5. Gandarías** (Sun 11 AM-12 AM) — sirloin (solomillo) pintxo + spider-crab stuffed pepper. The flexible late one.
- 6. La Viña** (Sun 7-11 PM — be here by 10:30) — FINISH: one slice of the original Basque burnt cheesecake + a glass of red. Grab a slice to go for La Concha tomorrow. MORE +

Walnut croissant + cortado at **Galparsoro Okindegia** (C. Mayor 6). Then 5 min walk to **Mercado de la Bretxa** (open Mon 8-2:30 — Sun was closed, Mon is the real shop day).

 **Optional — Pasaia/Pasajes port grills (fishermen's lunch)** (\$) 

15 min taxi (€18) OR Lurraldebus E09 from Plaza Gipuzkoa to Pasai San Pedro — **Donostia's actual working fishing port**. Where SS fishermen eat, not tourists. **Casa Cámara** (San Juan side, lift-up live lobster tank straight from the harbor, €40-60 pp) or budget pick **Txulotxo** (boat-to-grill bonito + besugo, €25-30 pp). Quick lunch (if skipped Pasaia) — Bar Txepetxa anchovy pintxos (\$)

BEFORE YOU GO

-  **Michelin LOCKED & CONFIRMED: Berasategui (3★)** — **Sat Jun 27, 8:45 PM, table for 2** ↗ (off the waiting list). Note on file: Tasting Menu for 2, celebrating the 33-day trip. €395 pp. Closed Sun/Mon/Tue. Arzak, Akelaře, Kokotxa, Mirador de Uliá, Amelia all closed Sun in late June — Sat is the only Michelin night. Fallback only if plans change: eMe Be Garrote (Berasategui's casual 1★, open Sun, in town).
-  **SUNDAY PINTXOS CRAWL (Jun 28, 7:00 PM sharp)** — **Sun-open bars only:** Goiz-Argi (prawn brochette) → Casa Urola (steak/scallop) → La Cuchara de San Telmo (foie/octopus) → Atari Gastroleku (beef cheek) → Gandarías (sirloin) → La Viña (burnt cheesecake, closes 11 PM — be there by 10:30).  **Bar Néstor + Borda Berri are CLOSED Sundays** — do NOT route to them on the 28th. (Néstor's tortilla/txuleton + Borda Berri are a weekday/Sat lunch thing only — but Sat is the Berasategui day.)
- **Berasategui wine tip (Eddie = reds only):** skip the set pairing (≈7 glasses, leans white/sweet to match seafood). Tell the somm "bold reds, Cabernet style, €60-100/bottle, price before you open it." Rioja Gran Reserva / Ribera del Duero = the Silver Oak lane.
- **Molly Malone Irish Pub** = literally 2 doors from your hotel. Quick beer anytime.
- **Spa:** La Perla (BOOKED Sat 2:30 PM) handles the spa need. Hotel María Cristina is the luxe backup.
- **Mon last morning:** Galparsoro Okindegia (C. Mayor 6) for walnut croissant + cortado, then Mercado de la Bretxa for vacuum-sealed Idiazabal cheese for the Paris picnic.
- Skipped: La Viña as a meal (Eddie no — but cheesecake stop only is on the Sunday crawl), Mugaritz, Restaurante Chino Mandarin.
-  **Dani hidden gems (slot in Sun morning / Mon AM before train):**
 - **Tabakalera (former tobacco factory, now contemporary art)** ↗ — Plaza de las Cigarreras 1, 10 min walk from Parte Vieja. Massive 1913 factory converted to a free contemporary art center + rooftop terrace with view over Donostia rooftops to the bay. Free entry to all 6 floors of galleries + rooftop. Tue-Sun 11-9. **Slip in pre-train Mon Jun 29** (1 hr enough). The cinema downstairs (Sala 1) shows arthouse films + the bookshop is one of the best in Spain.
 - **Hidden Igeldo funicular + amusement park** ↗ — Plaza Funicular, Igeldo. The 1912 funicular climbs Monte Igeldo (the OTHER hill, west bay end — Monte Urgull is east). €3.75 RT, daily 11-8. At the top: a creaky 1910s amusement park with a wooden "Rio Misterioso" boat ride + a Ferris wheel hanging directly over the cliff. Free to walk around. **The best aerial view of La Concha** — Hemingway said so. Skipped per current plan (Urgull is the chosen hike) but flag it as a sunset alt if Urgull rains out.
 - **Mercado de San Martín — 2nd floor pintxos counters** ↗ — C/ de Urbieta 9, central SS, 6 min walk from hotel. The locals' market — way less crowded than Bretxa, with a full upstairs gastronomic floor. **Bar Pulpo** ↗ (counter, octopus everything €4-12), **El Rincón de Antonio** ↗ (Idiazabal flights + sidra). 30-min market sit-down lunch on the Sun, after the Urgull descent — if you skip La Cuchara crowd.
 - **Museo San Telmo — old convent + the giant Sert wall paintings** ↗ — Plaza Zuloaga 1, base of Monte Urgull (LITERALLY where the hike starts). A restored 16th-c Dominican convent — 11 monumental José María Sert sepia murals in the old church space depicting Basque history. €6, free Tue. Tue-Sun 10-8. Quick 45-min visit = combines with the Urgull hike start. **One of the most-photographed interiors in Spain and almost nobody knows it.**
 - **Casa Munoa engraving + perfume cellar** ↗ — C/ San Marcial 33. The Munoa family have been engraving silver and stationery in SS for 4 generations (1862). Tiny shop with original tools + custom monograms + a small bespoke perfume bar in the back (€80-180 takeaway bottles, sit-down sniff session by appt). M-F 10-2 + 4:30-8.
